Cancellation/Entry/Refund Policy

- *Weather Cancellation*: By noon Friday prior to competition. Please check: Facebook: [Steeple Hill Farm Dressage & Combined Test](#)
- *Competition Management Cancellation* (weather or otherwise): Full entry refund.
- *Competitor Cancellation/Scratch prior to closing date*: Full entry refund
- *Competitor Cancellation/Scratch after closing date*: Refund minus \$25 office fee OR roll over entry to next competition. If cancelled after next competition, No refund.
- Entry and payment must be received by the Entry Secretary on **or before closing** date.
- Entries must include 1) a completed entry form, 2) payment, 3) valid negative Coggins, and 4) SHF Release form (Coggins & release may be presented on the day of competition and will be kept on file for the calendar year).
- Entries without proper payment will not be processed.

Management may split, cancel, or combine classes and add or substitute judges.

- Each competition – Introductory Level AND Training Level and above
- Year-End Series Award – Introductory Level AND Training Level and above

Facility

- Dressage Ring: Tests are held in 20m x 40m or 20m x 60m (as appropriate)
- Warm-up areas: are separate for Dressage & Stadium jumping
- Parking: designated areas are easy pull-thru and turn around for competitors with ample parking for spectators.

Rules

- **ASTM-approved Helmet and Medical Armband are required when mounted.**
- Show will be held in accordance with the current rules of USDF, USEA, USEF, and WDAA.
- Tack and Bits: Restricted to USDF, USEA, USEF, and WDAA Rules. No Exceptions.
- Boots & Leg Wraps are allowed.
- Children must be supervised
- Braiding & Coats are optional
- Concessions will be available.
- Dogs must be left at home.
